Early Childhood Program Pre-Kindergarten Curriculum Guide

Bible - Purposeful Design

The Purposeful Design Bible series focuses on the foundational teachings from the Bible about the nature and character of God, the qualities of His people, and His church. Students are given an overview of the Bible, with an emphasis on God's attributes, biblical characters, the early Church, and what it means to know Jesus Christ and live for Him.

Our pre-kindergarteners focus on familiar Bible lessons presented from both the Old Testament and New Testament, emphasizing God's love.

Math - Saxon

Saxon math focuses on an incremental development and continual review approach. Pre-kindergartners will develop skills including oral counting; recognizing and sequencing numbers; identifying ordinal position; acting out addition and subtraction stories; counting with one-to-one correspondence; sorting; patterning; graphing real objects and pictures; identifying and counting pennies, nickels, and dimes; identifying one half; identifying shapes; covering and replicating geometric designs; measuring using nonstandard units of measure; telling time to the hour; and using a calendar.

Handwriting and Writing – Abeka

Students learn how to form legible letters through tracing examples and writing exercises. They will have the opportunity to practice phonics while improving their writing.

Reading and Phonics – Abeka

Students are introduced to basic phonics through age-appropriate activities, helping them to read one-vowel and two-vowel words. Students will learn to recognize all letters and the sounds that they make. Vowel and consonant sounds are reinforced through short, phonics-based readers, which help students to form complete words and sentences.

Readiness Skills – Abeka

Readiness skills are developed through many activities in pre-kindergarten to promote hand-eye coordination, visual perception, and thinking skills.
