Our thoughts and prayers are with all of our families throughout this time.

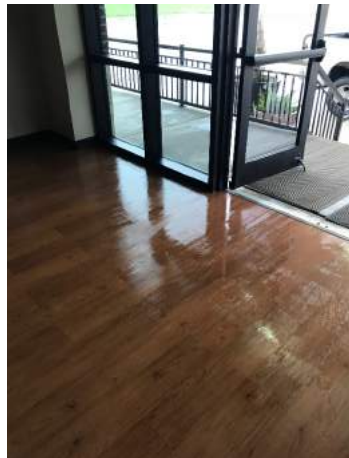
